CARPET STYLES





CUT PILE PLUSH

The yarn ends are closely cropped to create a smooth, almost velvet type surface. Each tuft is cut at the same height to create a luxurious finish.





MULTI LEVEL LOOP

Multi level loop pile is created by using loops of various heights to create a textured appearance. The loops in the carpet make it extremely durable for medium to high-traffic areas.





CUT PILE TWIST

Constructed with a high twisted yarn, the pile lies in different directions, giving a more textured appearance.





LEVEL LOOP PILE

Level loop pile carpet has all of the loops at a uniform length. It has a distinct texture with low and tight loops which do not show footprints. This is a great carpet choice for very high traffic areas.

SELECTING YOUR CARPET



Before selecting your carpet, consider who will be using those rooms, and how you'll be living in them. How much foot traffic will be coming through the room? Do you have children and pets?

THE THICKER THE BETTER

Performance of your carpet is related to the quality of the fibres and density of the plush pile. The thicker the pile, the better your carpet will perform.

THINK LIGHTING

You should also preview a sample in various different lights within your home to gauge how colour appearance can change dependant on the types of lighting within the room.

TRACKING

Carpets with soft luxurious high pile can be susceptible to tracking – a temporary situation - but one that can show foot imprints and vacuum lines. Your personal taste will determine whether this is a concern for you.

DURABILITY

Signature's carpets are tested for durability to ensure they will stand up to the demands of active family life. Giving you the ultimate softness underfoot without compromising performance.

COLOUR

Available in a variety of vibrant colours that are made to last, your carpet can express your personality and set the vibe for your room. Calming neutrals or bold accent colours? The choice is yours.

CARPET CHARACTERISTICS

COLOUR VARIATION

It is normal for installed carpet to show minor variation from samples or between production runs, and colour appearance can vary, depending on the type of light. It's important to view the sample at your residence and under as many different light conditions as possible before making your final decision.

FADING

As with any dyed or natural textile, the material will slowly lose colour when exposed to direct sunlight. It is recommended to limit the amount of direct sunlight and move furniture around to expose all areas of the carpet evenly.

DAMAGED OR MISSING TUFTS

Tufts may be identified as missing following stretching of your carpet during installation, or potentially damage caused by pets scratching or the moving of furniture. We recommend to keep a small piece of spare carpet for tufts to be replaced through hand-tufting by a skilled installer.

MATTING

Matting is the physical entanglement of the yarn fibres, which is more likely to occur in high traffic areas. Adequate vacuuming and the removal of soiling and moisture can help reduce foreign residue from accumulating on the pile and resulting in a clumped or matted appearance.

PILE REVERSAL AND SHADING

Pile reversing and shading give a patch of carpet a lighter or darker appearance, sometimes referred to as watermarking, this is dependant on the way the light is hitting that patch of carpet. It is not a manufacturing fault, and does not affect the performance of your carpet.

TRACKING AND FOOT MARKING

This will generally be more noticeable on cut pile or plusher longer pile carpets. This is not permanent and personal taste will come into consideration when selecting your carpet.

WRINKLING & RUCKING

This may occur after installation due to a number of reasons, such as fluctuation in humidity or excessive humidity, sub-floor variations, inadequate carpet cushioning, or not following our recommended installation procedures, especially with respect to carpet tensioning.

PROTECTING YOUR CARPET



Woven to withstand everything life can throw at them, there are also some easy steps you can take to help protect your carpet.

WIPE YOUR FEET

A basic doormat at entryways will capture a lot of the soil, moisture and grime that would otherwise end up in your carpet pile, can contribute to matting.

ROTATE FURNITURE

Rearrange your furniture occasionally to prevent indentation, and allow all areas of the carpet to see the light. Plastic mats or furniture cups can also protect your pile from chair castors and alleviate pressure marks.

THE RIGHT CLEANER

Ensure you're not accidentally using a household cleaner with bleach as this can discolour or dissolve your carpet fibres.

FILTERED LIGHT

Use curtains and sheers to filter sunlight and avoid prolonged exposure of direct sunlight.

VACUUM OFTEN

Frequency is the key when it comes to removing soil and grit before it has a chance to make its way further down into the pile where it can wear down the carpet fibres and become much more difficult to remove.
